

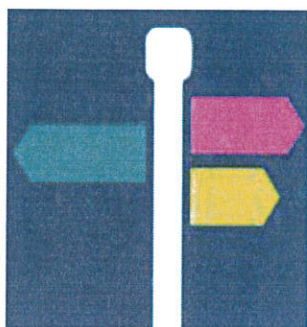
This year we've reached 2214 people on social media
