Be aware that all purchases of alcohol are subject to an online verification procedure. It is a criminal offence for anyone under the age of 18 to buy or attempt to buy alcohol and for anyone to buying or attempting to buy alcohol for persons under the age of 18. This system keeps a register of all purchases made and attempted purchases. The company will also be required to include a date of birth box on the website together with a fraudulent payment notice. 3. That the online electronic system for age verification must be capable of recording

		<p>refusals and providing a log of such refusals. A record of such refusals must be provided to responsible authorities on request.</p> <p>4. As far as reasonably practical alcohol shall only be delivered to the named persons on the purchase. The carrier will be require proof of ID and the signature of the persons receiving the delivery before leaving the said goods.</p> <p>5. That bottled beers sales be restricted to multiple sales only.</p>
