Consultation on Hackney Carriage Vehicles

Local authorities can, but do not have to, limit the number of hackney carriages in its area. If a local authority wishes to limit the number the number of hackney carriages it must be satisfied that there is no "unmet demand". (Times in the day or evening where the public are unable to get a hackney carriage vehicle)

To evidence any unmet demand, a survey must be undertaken. The law does not place any requirements on local authorities wishing to remove limits on hackney carriage vehicles - they are free to do so at any time

Blackburn with Darwen Council last considered this issue in 2012/3 when a survey was commissioned. The surveys can only be relied on for a period of three years, so to maintain a limit on the hackney carriage fleet another survey will need to be commissioned.

1) To delimit entirely the number of hackney carriage vehicles and, allow market forces to determine the number of hackney licences within the borough.
