**1 Declarations of Interest**

**2 Application for a Premises Licence – Savoy Self Service Garage Savoy Filling Station, Blackburn Road, Darwen, Lancashire BB3 1ET.**

The Sub-Committee considered an application for a Premises licence in respect of Savoy Self Service Garage Savoy Filling Station, Blackburn Road, Darwen, Lancashire BB3 1ET.

All responsible authorities had been consulted and advertisements had been displayed in accordance with the provisions of the Licensing Act. A number of objections had been received from residents in the area and ward councillors. Objections had been raised under the protection of children from harm objective, prevention of crime and disorder and the public nuisance objective. Details of objections from residents and Councillors were attached to the report however no residents were in attendance at the meeting.

In considering the application for the Premises Licence, Members took into account the information presented by Public Protection Officers Council's Trading Standards Officer, local residents and Ward Councillors. Prior to making representation all responsible authorities had been consulted and advertisements had been displayed in accordance with the provisions of the Licensing Act. The committee were informed that the conditions proposed by the licensing officer relating to staff training, training records and challenge 25 had been accepted by the applicant.

Following submissions by the Council's Public Protection and Trading Standards Service, and the representations from a personal licence holder, the Sub-Committee retired to seek legal advice.

The Chair of the Sub Committee advised those present that in reaching a decision, the Sub Committee had considered the Licensing Act 2003 and the section 182 guidance, relevant human rights articles, representations from the Police, the DPS Premises Licence Holder, Trading Standards Officer and the Council's Public Protection Service.

**RESOLVED** – That the Application for a Premises Licence in respect of Savoy Self Service Garage, Blackburn Road Darwen, be granted subject to the following conditions being imposed:

- Challenge 25 scheme to be adopted.
- All staff to complete Award in Responsible Alcohol Retailing Course (ARAR)
- CCTV system to be operational.
- Refusal book to be maintained and checked on regular basis

Both parties were informed of the decision of the Sub-Committee.
