REFUSES

consent for the above development in accordance with the details given on the application form and submitted plans. Permission is refused for the following REASONS:

 The proposed development, by virtue of a substandard separation distance, fails to secure a satisfactory level of amenity for the occupiers of No. 21 Shear Brow, contrary to Policy 8 of the Blackburn with Darwen Borough Local Plan Part 2 (December 2015) and RES E3 of the Residential Design Guide Supplementary Planning Document (September 2012).
