Dear Sir/Madam,

Your application to work on protected trees was received on 02/02/2018, and has been **GRANTED**.

Consent is limited to 2 years from the date of this letter and if the work has not been completed by this time a new application must be made.

It is imperative that you assure yourself that the arboriculturalist that undertakes the above works has insurance cover up to £1,000,000 for any one claim.

This letter and any attachments form a legal document and should be kept safe. Contravention of a Tree Preservation Order is a criminal offence. The above works should be carried out in accordance with British Standard 3998 (2010) Tree Work and not exceeded.

YOUR RIGHT OF APPEAL

If you disagree with our decision, you can appeal to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions. If you want to appeal, you must do so by writing to The Planning Inspectorate (England), Temple Quay House, 2 The Square, Temple Quay, Bristol, BS1 6PN, within 28 days from the date of this decision.

COMPENSATION

If you suffer any loss or damage as a result of our decision, you may be entitled to recover compensation from the Council. If you wish to make a claim you must do so within 12 months from the date of this decision (or, if you appeal to the Secretary of State, within 12 months from the date of his decision).
