1.0 PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

The purpose of the report is to advise the Committee of a petition received regarding parking issues on Springfield Avenue, Blackburn.

2.0 BACKGROUND

A Traffic Improvement Application was received by the traffic team on the 17th June 2016 from a resident of Springfield Avenue, requesting that parking at the entrance to the street from Preston Old Road is restricted. A petition in support of the application was attached to the request.

The petition was signed by 14 residents from a total of 18 properties on Springfield Avenue and by 2 residents from the 2 properties on Preston Old Road adjacent to the junction.

3.0 DETAIL

Springfield Avenue is a short quiet cul-de-sac off Preston Old Road, Blackburn. Residents complain that non-residents park their vehicles on both sides of the entrance to the street near to its junction with Preston Old Road resulting in Springfield Avenue being narrowed to a single lane at its entry/exit point to a busy main road. This has put residents at risk whilst accessing their road.

It is recommended that the residents' request for Parking restrictions at the entrance to Springfield Avenue be approved and a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) be processed for the provision of Double Yellow Lines in this area.
