3	<p><b><u>DETAIL</u></b></p> <p>3.1 Mr Osama Nazir, of 44 Perry Street, Darwen, BB3 3DG applied for an enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service check as part of this application for a new dual Driver licence.</p> <p>3.2 The Rehabilitation of Offender's Act 1974 does not apply to applicants for Dual Driver licences. The certificate issued on 27<sup>th</sup> October 2022 includes convictions which are relevant considerations (<b>Appendix 1</b>).</p> <p>3.3 The DBS Update Service has been checked on 19<sup>th</sup> April 2023. There is no further information.</p> <p>3.4 An online check of Mr Nazir's driving licence is provided at <b>Appendix 2</b> which confirms endorsements recorded on his statutory driving licence.</p> <p>3.5 Mr Osama Nazir has submitted a valid application form on 9<sup>th</sup> March 2023 (<b>Appendix 3</b>) and was interviewed by Janet White, Senior Public Protection Officer on 30<sup>th</sup> March 2023 in relation to this application (<b>Appendix 4</b>).</p> <p>3.6 Mr Nazir successfully passed the Council's driver training and knowledge test on the 30<sup>th</sup> November 2022 and the practical driver training course on 8<sup>th</sup> January 2023.</p> <p>3.7 He has submitted a satisfactory Group 2 medical dated 13<sup>th</sup> February 2023.</p> <p>3.8 Officers have checked the NR3 register and confirmed that Mr Nazir has not had any other application suspended or revoked with any other authority.</p>

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5	<p><b><u>POLICY REFERENCE</u></b></p> <p>5.1</p> <p>The criminal conviction is relevant to section 2 of the council’s conviction policy.</p> <p><b>Section 2 – Violence</b></p> <p>Members of the public and in particular, the elderly, infirm and children or vulnerable adults entrust their personal safety to private hire and hackney carriage drivers whenever they take a journey.</p> <p>Passengers often travel alone and are vulnerable to physical attack etc.</p> <p>Users of private hire and hackney carriage vehicles have a right to expect that drivers are not individuals with a predisposition towards or a propensity for violent behaviour at any level.</p> <p>i An application will also normally be refused where the individual has a conviction for an offence or similar offence(s) or similar offence(s) which replace the below offences and the conviction is less than 3 years prior to the date of application:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Criminal damage</li> </ul> <p>5.2</p> <p>The motoring convictions are relevant to section 6 of the council’s conviction policy.</p> <p><b>Section 6 - MOTORING CONVICTIONS - MAJOR TRAFFIC OFFENCES</b></p> <p>New applicants and existing licensed drivers with a conviction for a ‘Major Traffic Offence’ as defined below, which is less than 5 years prior to the date of the application (the present date in relation to existing licensed drivers) will be referred to the Panel for determination. A conviction less than 2 years prior to the date of the application will generally be refused.</p>															

Where the conviction resulted in a period of disqualification, an application will normally be refused unless a period of 3 years free from conviction has lapsed from the restoration of the DVLA licence and 5 years where the disqualification relates to driving whilst unfit through drink or drugs.

In addition, applicants will generally be required to show a period of at least 5 years has elapsed after completion of detoxification treatment if they were an alcoholic.

**For the purposes of these guidelines the following motoring offences are classed as ‘Major Traffic Offences’:**

IN10	Using a vehicle uninsured against third party risks
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### **MINOR TRAFFIC OFFENCES**

Any Minor Traffic Offence which has attracted 4 or more penalty points will be treated as though it were an Intermediate Traffic Offence

#### **Single conviction**

Where an individual has a single Minor Traffic Offence in the 12 months immediately preceding the date of application, the application will normally be granted with a letter of warning being placed on the file.

SP30	Exceeding statutory speed limit on a public road resulting in a fixed penalty
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### 5.3 **Statutory Guidance**

The Sub-Committee must also take into account the [Government’s Statutory Taxi & Private Hire Vehicle Standards 2020](#).

Paragraph 5.12 headed ‘The Fit and Proper Test’ states:

Licensing authorities have a duty to ensure that any person to whom they grant a taxi or private hire vehicle driver’s licence is a ‘fit and proper’ person to be a licensee. It may be helpful when considering whether an applicant or licensee is fit and proper to pose oneself the following question:

**Without any prejudice, and based on the information before you, would you allow a person for whom you care, regardless of their condition, to travel alone in a vehicle driven by this person at any time of day or night?**

If, on the balance of probabilities, the answer to the question is ‘no’, the individual should not hold a licence.

### **6 RECOMMENDATION**

- Members grant the application subject to the standard conditions
- Members refuse the application

### **7 LEGAL IMPLICATIONS**

Any person aggrieved by the decision of the Sub-Committee has a right of appeal to the Magistrates Court, within 21 days of the service of the decision notice.

**Outline of circumstances surrounding the offence / caution / complaint**

Mr Ahmed provided the following accounts in respect of 3 occasion's where his conduct has been complained about.

The first one is the incident on 21<sup>st</sup> March 2023. Mr Ahmed was shown the footage and provided the following account. He say that the other driver came passed him at the traffic light junction and then cut in front of him on Montague Street and braked hard, causing Mr Ahmed to have to brake suddenly and he sounded his horn.

He says the other driver continued to drive and then brake and so Mr Ahmed went to overtake him. Mr Ahmed pulled in front of him and got out of his car to speak to him. He says the other driver was aggressive and hit one of the rear panels of the taxi. The other driver was shouting abuse at Mr Ahmed so he pushed him away, but he persisted so Mr Ahmed pushed him again. Mr Ahmed then got back into his car and says that the children's safety was his concern as much as anything.

Mr Ahmed then recalled an incident back in February when he was on his way to pick up the passenger assistant. There was a B&B taxi, a VW Caddy on Queens Park Road and Mr Ahmed was right on the corner of Queens Park Road and Pringle Street. The road was very narrow and the VW drove into the gap between parked cars and myself. I couldn't move at that point and the other driver wound his window down and banged on my car. I pulled out as soon as I was able to, to collect the passenger assistant. The other driver complained to the PH Association but they did not take any more action. I did get a letter from licensing, although no-one contacted me about it.

The PLO then asked about an incident when Mr Ahmed was waiting to collect one of the boys on the Council contract. He says he was parked on Preston New Road opposite a traffic island near to the boys home. A male who he estimated to be in his late 20's carrying a few bags was crossing the road when he became very abusive to me using foul language because he had to walk round my car. I was outside my vehicle waiting to help the child into the car. I told the man to be patient and just walk round. The child's mum was also abused by this man.

I have been driving for a long time on and off since the early 80's but in the last 11 years I have worked full time as a taxi driver and not had any problems before or had to go to Committee.
