1. DECISION

The Director agrees to award the Advocacy and IV and Mentoring and Befriending contract to Barnardo's.

2. REASON FOR DECISION

A tender process was carried out. The opportunity was advertised on The Chest on 15th January 2021. Two potential bids were received. These bids were evaluated by a panel of 3 members and the bid to receive the highest marks was Barnardo's.

3. BACKGROUND

There is a statutory requirement for LAs to ensure that all our looked after children have access to advocacy, IV and mentoring and befriending as and when required. This provision and service should also be avaible to children subject to child protection plans.

In order to ensure that the service is independent from other key professionals, is child centred in supporting the views of the child by ensuring their views are heard and focuses on the right of the child, BwD have always commissioned this service.

The cost of the commission is built into the participation budget.

4. KEY ISSUES AND RISKS

As Barnardo's is currently already delivering this service there will be no disruption to delivery.

5. OPTIONS CONSIDERED AND REJECTED

The opportunity was advertised fairly and open to all interested parties. Evaluations were completed using a fair process outlined in the invitation to tender documentation. Barnardos was deemed the most suitable option.
