Dear Resident,

Blackburn with Darwen Borough Council is conducting a survey to help us better understand residents' views and opinions about disabled parking bay provision in the borough. Your household has been selected at random to take part in the survey.

We are only asking about residential disabled parking bays. These are dedicated parking spaces marked out on the street, in a residential area.

Over the last twenty years the number of applications for residential disabled parking bays has increased significantly. The increase in the number of parking bays means the cost to the council is also increasing and becoming unaffordable. Also, in some streets there are multiple disabled bays, which can cause traffic congestion and problems for parking.
